

The Commercial New Construction Program provides support for whole-building energy modeling as a design tool and offers incentives to help offset the capital cost of efficient construction. Suitable for commercial, institutional, and multi-unit residential new construction projects.

To qualify for the program, the project must be in design phase and must be pursuing electrical energy savings.*

- Eligible projects receive a modeling incentive of up to \$15,000.
- Energy-saving designs will receive a customized implementation incentive, with value determined from the project's modeled energy performance.

3. Incentive Commitment:


When the design is finalized and energy model is complete,
